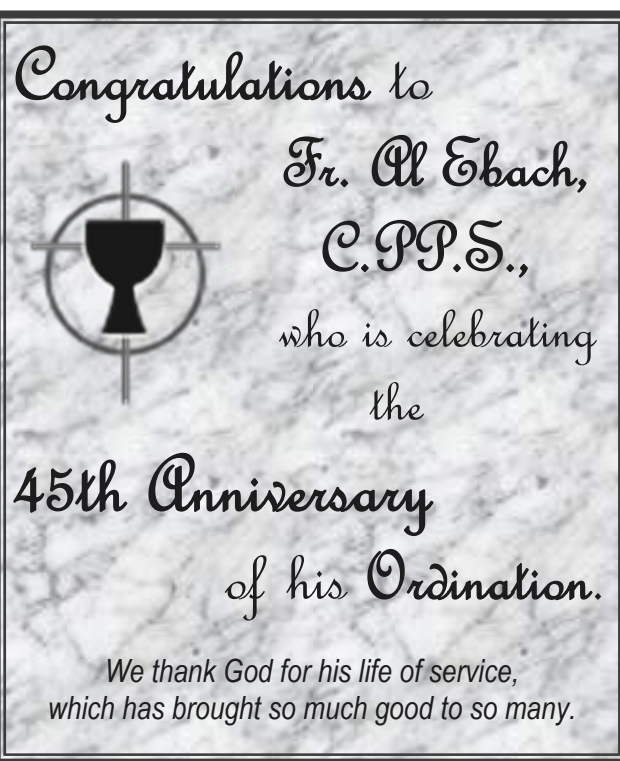

New Parishioners

Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

In the Gospel of John, on the feast of Pentecost, which we celebrate this weekend, Jesus invites the disciples to minister to the people of God through the gift of the Holy Spirit: "As the Father has sent me so I send you." And then he said to them: "Receive the Holy Spirit." It was at this time that the Church, as we know it, began. The disciples were sent as Jesus was. Last weekend we celebrated the feast of the Ascension, Jesus returning to the right hand of the Father, and this weekend we celebrate God continuing the life of the Church through the Holy Spirit. So, what does that mean for us? We, like the disciples, are invited to minister in the name of Jesus Christ, through the gift of the Holy Spirit, which we celebrate on this feast day of Pentecost. It is not just an event, which we read or hear about in scripture, but it is Jesus' instruction to all of us, in which we are called to participate.

How do we become the embodiment of the Holy Spirit in our Church? Our participation as Church takes more than just our personal attendance at the Eucharist, although receiving the Eucharist is very much part of Church. At the end of Mass the priest sends the people forth to love and serve the Lord; we are called to participate in Eucharist outside of the church building. This past weekend we experienced the Church alive in the name of the Holy Spirit through the Little Sisters of the Poor, who invited us to participate in their apostolate by sharing our resources to help them serve the elderly poor. They shared that our parishioners were so inviting and generous. We also experienced the Spirit alive in one of our own, Deacon Robert Johnson, who was ordained a deacon to serve the Church in the diocese of Lincoln, Nebraska. The Holy Spirit also seemed to be alive through the Knights of Columbus who shared their gift of time assisting The Smith family from our parish, who sustained damage from last week's tornado in Kearney. Many other parishioners have also been involved in the name of the Holy Spirit by caring for the sick and elderly in our parish family, bringing the Spirit of healing to them. There are also a number of people committing their time and energy to assist our children at our Vacation Bible School in July, helping bring the word of Christ to our children. These are just a few examples of the Spirit alive I observed last weekend, and I know others continue to celebrate the Spirit through many other ministries. Again, in order for us to be alive in the Spirit we have to be intentional about it; we must use our God-given gifts to be Church to one another. Thanks to all for being Church in the name of the Holy Spirit, which we celebrate this weekend, on the feast of Pentecost.
