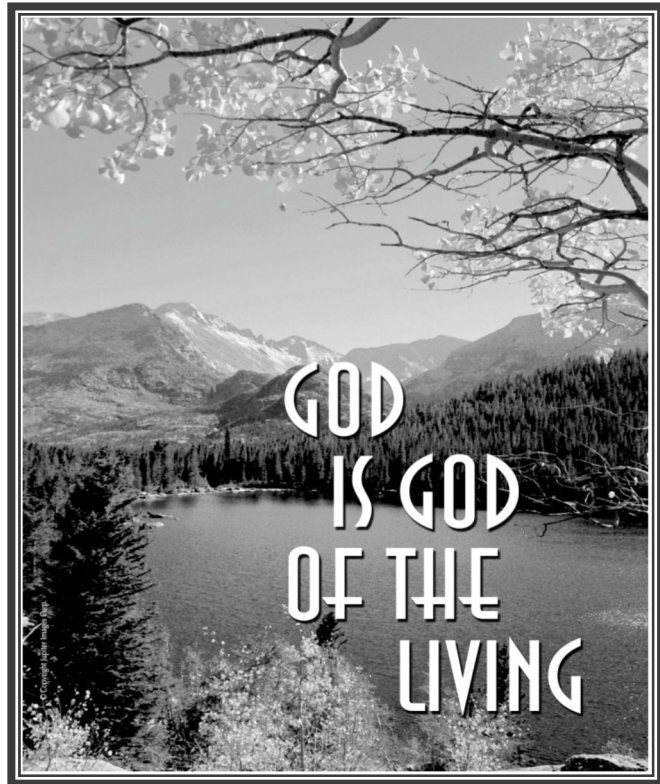

Welcome to Church of the Annunciation

This weekend is the parish kick-off for the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA), which is an appeal through the diocese of Kansas City - St. Joseph. A goal is set for each parish of the diocese to achieve. The goal for the Church of the Annunciation is \$23,775. This is about the same assessment we were given in 2019. We almost reached our goal, short only a little over \$1000 in 2019. Thank you so much to all who contributed to this cause last year. Not only were we close to reaching our goal, we had a record number of people who participated. If everyone donates a little we can easily meet our goal. Many of you have already received your letters regarding the ACA, along with a pledge card. You can choose to either pledge or make a one-time donation. I realize that many of you are very generous with your stewardship to the parish, and wonder why you have to also support the diocese. Actually, our stewardship to the diocese assists us in our parish. The diocese supports the parish through the following ministries: Social services and outreach, such as Catholic Charities, with education and faith formation, and with Pastoral ministries, which includes liturgy, seminary formation and youth. I encourage you to be as generous as you possibly can. Thank you to those of you who have already contributed to the ACA for 2020.

I also want to make a brief comment about the Taste of the Annunciation we celebrated last Saturday evening. There were about 140 people who were served, about 30, who provided and served the food, and around 30 people who provided entertainment. Thanks to all who participated in this event. The event gifted the Capital Campaign with over \$2000. More importantly, it was a great social gathering for many parishioners and their families and friends. I want to thank people who provided the food for the gathering. All the food provided was donated by the specific ethnic groups. One can only imagine the cost of all the food and drink items that were provided and served. Again, we have many generous parishioners who share so many of their resources to invite us to truly be parish. Thank you!

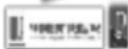
