If you come to Mass and find too many people inside for your comfort level, please know there is no shame in choosing to participate in the parking lot or at home. Masks are still required in the church for weekend Masses as we get used to more people present.

As we begin to return to normal, we are seeking new or returning greeters for all the weekend Masses. As a greeter, you will be the first person that our parishioners see as they arrive for Mass, and your primary job will be to welcome them. # FAITH FORMATION

### FOR WHAT IT'S WORTH: THOUGHTS ON FAITH Erin Nieves – <u>erin@h-t.org</u>

When you say "AMEN", say it like you mean it! Let's think about our prayers. First, how do we start them? We begin with, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We begin by invoking the Holy Trinity that is God, and by making the sign of the cross as we say these words, we wrap ourselves in the embrace of God Himself.

Then, we pray. Think of what *pray means*. We *ask*, we *appeal*, we *urge*, and we *recite*, and when we are finished, we say *AMEN*! When we pray with others, like with our priests and deacon at Mass, we listen and take their prayer in, and when their prayer ends, we also respond with *AMEN*. Whether they are our **personal prayers or the prayers we participate in at Mass**, we pray, **meaning what we say**. *Don't we*?

The words of the prayer of the Mass has, for thousands of years, proclaimed the truth of our faith both ancient and new. *Amen* lets us say, "*Exactly*, *I couldn't have said it better myself!*" and that "*I certainly, and truly, and verily mean what we just prayed together.*" Whenever we pray, let's appreciate the beautiful dialogue that we are entering into. It is our God who enters it with us, and we know He means what He says!

*"For no matter how many promises God has made, they are 'Yes' in Christ."* 2 Cor 1:20

And to this, I invite all of us to say, "AMEN!" +
