# BRETT'S TWO CENTS

Hello, everyone! A number of you have noticed that I've been exhibiting a bit of paralysis on the right side of my face; I thought I would address this here, just to help allay concerns. A couple of weeks ago, I was diagnosed with a mild form of Bells Palsy. Bells involves the inflammation of the facial nerve, usually on one side of the face, and can result in drooping, partial facial paralysis, loss of taste, difficulty swallowing, etc. Thankfully, mine has been limited to the paralysis, and even that seems to be improving with treatment.

Most often Bells will resolve on its own, though medications, facial exercises, and acupuncture can be very helpful in speeding things along. Medical professionals are not sure what causes Bells; in some cases, it seems to be linked to a viral infection, though in most cases they're not sure. Still, the good news: I am not having a stroke! And I'm not in any pain. Mostly it's an inconvenience and an irritant (in terms of the attention it draws). I'm very aware that many of you are carrying much heavier burdens!

Someone sent me the following quote to pray with. I thought I would share it with all of you:

*"Habits are being formed here under the pressure of temptation and difficulty that unfold in perfect form and beauty when the soul that has developed these habits passes into its true home. Those very temptations that made it so difficult to persevere were really the means of developing these powers. The spirit of prayer and worship grew on; hampered and oppressed by the distractions of life, it fought its way in spite of them and thus gained strength; then, when all these were removed, it opened out unhindered in its perfect growth. Now, there is one fundamental principle of the spiritual life that has to be learned and practiced here, mostly with suffering, often with the very keenest suffering. Although so closely associated with it that it almost seems a necessary part of it, suffering is indeed only accidental, and one day will altogether cease, while the grace that has been fought for and developed in so much agony will live on forever, and be the delight of the soul through eternity."*

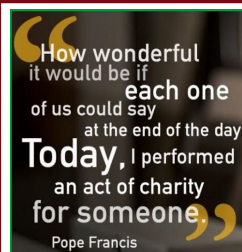

Now that the summer is in full swing, we are starting to see an uptick in demand. With schools closed and the Village Pantry shutting down, we have been planning for an increase and this week we started to see it: we are up 12% in people served over last week. For those of you that have dropped off food or made a donation, thank you. The people we serve are very grateful for your generosity.

I thought I would share a couple of encounters that I was able to witness this past week that remind me why we do what we do here at the Food Closet. We have a gentleman who is a regular client, very outgoing and kind. I had the opportunity to have a conversation with him and the first thing he said is that he doesn't feel *Mahalo*. And when he said that, I took it as he was missing compassion, something he felt much stronger in Hawai'i but was missing here. The next week I recognized him and said hello. I explained that we were going to say a prayer before we began food service. He asked if he could join the prayer service, and my response was, of course. I hope in that moment we were we able to give him a little sense of *Mahalo*.

A few days later we had a couple show up not needing food but money for gas. In the recent weeks they had a multitude of bad things happen to them and they were devastated. I saw the volunteer give the couple a gift card and the next minute I saw the three of them praying together. I was touched. We don't ask or tell clients to pray, but if they ask or feel that is what they need in that moment, I am glad that we are able to help.

I am always touched and amazed at how compassionate our volunteers are and nothing exemplifies that more than when a young person with no car and just a backpack on their back shows up. These volunteers go into full parent-mode, making sure they not only get food but try to think of anything else the person would need. I am truly grateful to witness this in action; it's inspiring.

Lastly, I just wanted to share with you that the following high schools will be giving out free breakfasts and lunches for all children ages 1-18, from June 28 – August 12 (Monday – Thursday) at 10:30-11:30am: Aloha, Beaverton, Mountainside, Southridge, Sunset, and Westview.
