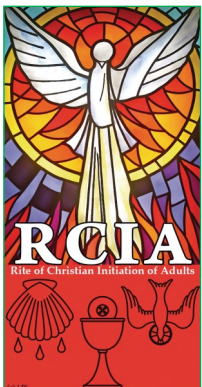
WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY

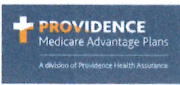

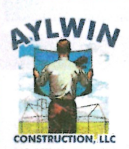
