GREETINGS FROM FR. DAVE

As Catholics we don't often use the language "born again" referring to our ongoing conversion to Jesus. We do believe FIRMLY in the need for making a decision to follow Jesus and on ongoing decision process to be true to him each day.

Our emphasis is less on a one-time commitment and more on the daily process of surrender, trust, and dying to self. A comparison can easily be made to marriage. The vows made on the wedding day are imperative – and equally so is the daily living out of those vows.

Part of my morning prayer always includes a careful praying of the traditional Morning Offering I was taught as a child:

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer you my prayers, work, joys, and suffering of this day for all the intentions of your Sacred Heart, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world, in reparation for my sins and for the whole world.

As I pray this prayer I intentionally offer to Jesus the known and unknown "prayers, work, joys, and suffering" of the day, and invite him into all of it. This is an important part of my own commitment to

follow Jesus and to be open to his presence in my life and through my life to others.

WEDNESDAY BIBLE STUDY


