## GREETINGS FROM FR. DAVE

Thank you again for your prayers for my recovery from COVID. I am making progress and grateful to have some energy returning. My annual vacation begins on Monday the 13<sup>th</sup>, so that will give me time to make a full recovery before returning in the beginning of October.

20 years since 9/11. Wow, how our lives have changed. Huge blessings on all whose lives were lost, on all first responders, all military personnel, and all working hard to keep us all safe. The following is the prayer prayed by both Pope Benedict XVI (2008) and Pope Francis (2015) when they visited Ground Zero.

### Papal Prayer when visiting Ground Zero

O God of love, compassion, and healing, look on us, people of many different faiths and traditions, who gather today at this site, the scene of incredible violence and pain.

We ask you in your goodness to give eternal light and peace to all who died here – the heroic first responders: our firefighters, police officers, emergency service workers, and Port Authority personnel, along with all the innocent men and women who were victims of this tragedy simply because their work or service brought them here on September 11, 2001.

We ask you, in your compassion to bring healing to those who, because of their presence here that day, suffer from injuries and illness.

Heal, too, the pain of still-grieving families and all who lost loved ones in this tragedy. Give them strength to continue their lives with courage and hope.

We are mindful, as well, of those who suffered death, injury, and loss on the same day at the Pentagon and in Shanksville, Pennsylvania. Our hearts are one with theirs as our prayer embraces their pain and suffering.

God of peace, bring your peace to our violent world: peace in the hearts of all men and women and peace among the nations of the earth.

Turn to your way of love those whose hearts and minds are consumed with hatred. God of understanding, overwhelmed by the magnitude of this tragedy, we seek your light and guidance as we confront such terrible events.

Grant that those whose lives were spared may live so that the lives lost here may not have been lost in vain.

Comfort and console us, strengthen us in hope, and give us the wisdom and courage to work tirelessly for a world where true peace and love reign among nations and in the hearts of all.



*A story personally my own.* In a word, our personal story is a story of our particular “*salvation history.*” Say what?!? Let me explain.

The moment we are born to the day we die records my (our) personal relationship with God. He has known us since before we were born, from the moment of our conception. Since that moment, God has been involved in my (our) life. Each day of my (our) lifetime records the evolution of that personal deliverance. It is an ebb and flow, marked with participation or defiant or lethargic disregard. Whatever it looks like, it's distinctly mine (ours).

Most beautiful in this is that God **NEVER** abandons us. Whether we know it or not, He has been with us every step of the way. He saves us, if we let Him, urging, and inviting us into a relationship with Him. As Catholics, we live this most tangibly through the Church. This *exchange* has a sacramental dimension that allows us to partake in the very life of God Himself.
