Confronting the Cross: All of us must face the cross of Jesus. If we are smart, we hold that as our personal insurance that indemnifies us against the wickedness and evil of this world. It is, after all, the weapon Jesus used to defeat incarnate evil, sin, and death for all humanity...including for you and me.

Our Church tells to *celebrate and exalt* the cross of Jesus. Do we know what that means? If not, try using *revere*, *extol*, *DIGNIFY*, *and WORSHIP*. And then, with the better understanding of our response to the *holy cross of Christ*, we do as Jesus asks us to do: we pick up *our own cross* and we follow Him. What is our cross? *It's a cross distinctly our own*.

"How often do I pick it up?" you ask. DAILY.

By recognizing the cross as the mechanism that Jesus used to save us, we admit that *our personal crosses* are a tool Jesus uses as well. Does God give us the crosses we bear? *NO!* But He uses them, always for our good, and the salvation of the whole world. So, we befriend our crosses, willingly embracing them. O Holy Cross of Jesus, transform me, redeem me, save me.

Let's especially pray this:

"We adore you O Christ, and we praise you, because by your holy cross you have redeemed the world." + (on this Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross, 9/14)


