Creighton Model Fertility Care System

"The CREIGHTON MODEL Fertility Care System (CrMS) is based upon the knowledge and understanding of the naturally-occurring phases of a woman's fertility and infertility. CrMS relies upon the standardized observation and charting of biological markers that are essential to a woman's gynecological and reproductive health. Now, a woman can know her cycles and use this information for the maintenance of her health. Further, couples can use this knowledge to plan their family and build their future together."

FAQs

Is CrMS the same thing as the calendar rhythm method? No! CrMS is specifically distinct from the calendar rhythm method. Rather than estimating the date of ovulation based upon the assumption of regular cycles, CrMS utilizes biological markers to identify days of fertility and infertility based on research conducted at the St. Paul VI Institute in

sed on research conducted at the St. Paul VI Institute i Omaha. This makes the system highly effective and applicable to women at all reproductive stages.

I'm not married or engaged. Is there any reason for me to use this system?

Absolutely! While it is a system that can be used by married couples to avoid or achieve pregnancy, it is a system that can also be used by single women to better understand their fertility and monitor for potential health problems.



We are beginning to ramp up the Backpack Program for the school year! Right now we have three schools we will be helping but that could increase as the school year progresses. We currently have plenty of small backpacks, but we could use some extra large backpacks; if you would like to donate a few, it would be appreciated!

Also, we have been receiving some food donations after hours the last few weeks. All donations are greatly appreciated — however, leaving foodstuff outside gives local birds and critters an opportunity to enjoy it first. We are in the process of having an outdoor drop box created; however, I would encourage you to please stop by during pantry hours: Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 9:00am to 12:30pm (we open at 10:00am but you can drop-off items while we're setting up).

If you can't make it during those times, take your donations to the Parish Office — they're open 8:00-4:30pm, Monday through Thursday, and on Friday from 8:00-2:00pm. You can also bring donations when you come to Mass on the weekend and put them in the large wooden boxes in the foyer by the elevator — just no perishables, please, as the boxes won't be checked until Tuesday.


