As we continue the cleanup after the storm for our two parishes we are seeing a slightly changing landscape of fewer trees at St. Mary and St. James. St. James is in full swing of a church basement restoration project with hoped for additional projects that will transform the basement classrooms for our CCD students from both our parishes in time for this fall. I hope that all will see this time of destructive winds of mother nature to be turned into opportunities of rebuilding and growth for our parishes.

So too I am excited about the new group of RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) candidates who are entering into full communion in the Catholic Church this coming Easter Vigil. I am once again looking forward to teaching the faith to these individuals this coming fall. In the past, I have held the RCIA classes after the 5pm Saturday evening Mass at St. Mary. I am looking at making a slight change to our weekend Mass schedule to better serve the RCIA and Adult Faith Formation program for this fall.

After consultation of both St. Mary and St. James Pastoral Council members. I have decided to strike a compromise that will hopefully satisfy both parishes and their needs. I have presented to them my desire to bring the RCIA Faith Formation program to St. James by having a 4pm Saturday evening Mass at St. James for the duration of the RCIA Program from September thru Palm **Sunday**. The RCIA Faith Formation classes will immediately begin after the 4pm Mass in the Gathering Space at St. James with ease of access to the kitchen for a small meal during the RCIA class. St. Mary will be assured to have the regular 5pm Saturday evening Mass for the remaining timeframe from Divine Mercy Sunday through the Labor Day Weekend. With this change, that benefits both parishes, Christmas 4pm Mass will be at St. James. St. Mary will have a later Christmas Vigil Mass which will be determined in the near future. The Triduum will still remain at St. Mary as in the past. I believe this is a balanced compromise that both parishes can agree upon as we continue to grow our membership with new Catholics coming into the faith and into our church families.

We indeed are seeing a changing landscape around us which entails new growth and continued strengthening of the faith we have in God and in each other. I pray that the above news will bring both new excitement and a continued growing together between our two parishes as we see God as the center of all that we do for the Glory of God's Name and the building up of God's Kingdom.

Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: www.diolc.org . Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. St. James Parishioners Annual Building/Maintenance

Contribution. Each year, in your contribution boxes, there is an envelope designated as "Building/Maintenance" with a \$50.00 suggested donation printed on it. This year the envelope is dated July 7th. We have a list of maintenance items that need to be addressed caused by a difficult winter, as well as on-going issues related to excess water and seepage in the Church basement. We will need to address these issues, and we should consider adding to the maintenance fund to address future needs of our beautiful Church. As a reminder, St.James does not hold an annual fundraiser, instead we ask our parishioners to reflect and prayerfully consider making this additional Building/Maintenance donation annually to keep up with increasing costs and general building repairs. All donations are greatly appreciated and greatly needed.

Finally, if you have been following the weekly contribution summary in the bulletin for St. James, you'll note that we have been averaging roughly \$10,000 per month in contribution revenue. Unfortunately, that is not enough to cover our annual expenses and we have needed to withdraw money from our savings account for the past few years. Father Hackel and the St. James and St. Mary's Finance Councils are looking for interested parishioners to join a "Focus Group" on stewardship (with stewardship including not just financial, but just as importantly our time and talents). James Miller was born into a family of farmers near Stevens Point on September 21, 1944, attended Pacelli High School, and joined the De La Salle Christian Brothers in 1959. He served as a missionary in Nicaragua and then Guatemala, where he was shot and killed by 3 hooded men on Feb. 13, 1982, during Guatemala's civil war. Pope Francis decreed that he died a martyr for the Faith and has set his beatification for Dec. 7, 2019 in Huehuetenango, Guatemala.
