The church has always held to the belief that Mary was assumed, body and soul, into a heavenly state, even though the belief was not declared as dogmatic until 1950. The early church had a robust tradition of revering relics from the saints of the day, and their complete lack of relics from the Mother of Jesus was seen as evidence of this Marian belief. The celebration of the event as a feast dates back to the fourth century in the East and the seventh century in the West.

Since Mary was untouched by the stain of sin, she was unable to experience the "wages of sin," which is death. But her Assumption also says something about humanity as well. Sin only has power over us if we allow it. Mary was freed from this power in her Immaculate Conception, and when she responded "yes" to God. We were freed from that power when Jesus died and rose, conquering death. Now, we must respond "yes" to claim the victory that was already won for us. On this feast, we should not only celebrate the great works God has done for us through Our Lady, but also celebrate the truth that we have the opportunity to one day spend eternity with her and her Son, Jesus.

From Annunciation to Christmas – <u>"For you created my</u> inmost being, you knit me together in my Mother's womb." <u>Psalm 139:13</u> Our Baby is now <u>20 weeks</u>. We are in the second trimester! See the growth & development of our Preborn Baby during their 18th, 19th & 20th week of life. In the <u>18th week</u>, he/she has unique waking & sleeping patterns & even has a favorite position to sleep in. In the <u>19th week</u> lifesaving surgery has been successfully performed on babies at this age. In the <u>20th week</u> up until about the 32 weeks, the baby feels pain more intensely than at any other time in development. Praying book club Our next gathering will be on Thurs, Aug. 15, 5:30 pm at St. James. We are finishing Sherry Weddell's book, Forming Intentional Disciples. Weddell describes the 5 thresholds of conversion people experience as they explore & develop a relationship with Christ. The thresholds are 1) Initial trust - a person is able to trust or has a positive association with Jesus, the Church, a believer, or something identifiably Christian 2) Spiritual curiosity - desiring to know more about Jesus 3) Spiritual openness - a person acknowledges to to self and to God that they are open to the possibility of a personal & spiritual change 4) Spiritual seeking - a person actively seeks to know more about God & seeks to know if they can commit to Christ in His Church 5) Intentional discipleship - a person makes a conscious decision to "drop one's nets" and follow Jesus. They reorder their life to live accordingly & become an obedient disciple.
