Our Baby is now **21 weeks**. We are in the **second trimester!** See the growth & development of our Preborn Baby during their 19th, 20th & 21st week of life. In the **19th week** life-saving surgery has been successfully performed on babies at this age. In the **20th week**, up until about the 32 weeks, the baby feels pain more intensely than at any other time in development. In the **21st week**, if a baby is born prematurely, up to 63% survive.
