## From Fr Dan, Praise be Jesus Christ.

Following up on Bishop DeGrood's vision for our Diocese- "Lifelong Catholic Missionary Discipleship Through God's Love", and his invitation for us to learn more about this through reading From Christendom to Apostolic Mission: Pastoral Strategies for an Apostolic Age (which a few are still in the entryways of each Church), we are encouraged to begin a book study on this during Lent. As we look at this, small group leaders are aided by videos and study guides created by our Diocesan staff (Fr Scott Traynor and Dr. Chris Burgwald). Each of their seven 10-15 minute videos come with a one-page discussion guide. Together, the video and discussion guide, lend themselves to a one-hour session and are designed for a seven-week study, but could easily be used in a two-day retreat format. Identify a person whom you have offended by your unkind words and pray for them each day for a week.

Donate your next babysitting wages to the poor.

For one whole week, do the dishes or set the table without being asked.
