Recap of HS PC meeting Oct. 20

Holy Spirit Parish Council members met at Holy Spirit (HS) Hall. Pastor Father Adam Westphal led the opening prayer. Present were Fr. Adam, Jacquie Eblen, Joni Taylor, Phyllis Allen, Lisa Miller, Mark O'Riley, Ronda Katzer, Barb Hudson, and Michelle Moore (recording secretary). Excused Absent: Joni Thelen. Motion was made by Lisa to approve the Sept 2020 meeting minutes, Mark seconded, all approved.

Fr. Adam Comments: Discussed Christmas Mass schedule. Fr. Adam is going to pursue if we can get Christmas Mass on the radio. He will work with Steve Heffern to determine which Mass should be recorded. Christmas Eve Mass will be at 4 pm and 10 pm and Christmas Day Mass at 9 am. The Christmas Eve Mass at 4 pm is generally very packed. It will be 1st come first serve with overflow going to the basement. We will be following social distancing. It was suggested, we have ushers (with masks) to help find pews for the 4 pm Mass.

Committee Reports: *Building and Grounds/ Safety Committee:* Remodeling of the men's bathroom at HS Hall will start sometime late Fall. HS FC approved the air conditioner blower to be repaired. Still waiting on repairs of HS church roof.

Family Life: Jacquie visited a new parishioner. The Public Square Rosary Rally went well. Thank you to Jacquie, Phyllis, and Steve Heffern for organizing it. Jacquie volunteered to help with Lighted Christmas Parade on Dec. 3 at 7 pm. She will hand out cards with the Mass times.

Social Concerns: Mark is helping with a project to provide bags of food at schools (160 bags) on Fridays so kids have food over the weekend. Mark will be organizing the Giving Tree at HS. Fr. Adam will be talking to the Creston Police about another program.

Liturgy: They have decorated the church for Fall. The pews look nice with white rope. Barb is organizing a cleaning day for HS on Oct. 23. She has been getting the vacuums ready and getting cleaning supplies.

Finance: Next finance meeting is in Nov. Phyllis reported tithing and ADA updates. HS is running short for both.

Faith Formation: RE has been going well, 1-8 grade and Sophomore confirmation students are meeting at STM school. Freshman confirmation prep students are meeting at HS Hall. Confirmation is planned to April 24 with Bishop Joensen.

St. Malachy: There is no public Mass on Wednesdays, but the Mass is live streamed from St. Malachy School and the 7th/8th graders are learning how to run, record, and edit the Mass. Discussion on a Catholic family from Osceola attending online school. Kitchen staff has been hired.

RCIA: Fr. Adam has three people attending RCIA.

Christmas Dinner: Anita Studer and Barb Hudson are volunteering to help with organizing the Christmas dinner. Mark & Ronda said they would also help. They will take preorders and day of orders. It will be drive by and pick up the meal or meals will be delivered to the elderly. They will use the STM kitchen. More details to come in the bulletin.

Other: Michelle showed the group this week's bulletin draft. Michelle has been using a free trial from LPI, called WeCreate to add pictures, quotes, weekly prayer, observances of the week, articles, and kid's corner to the bulletin and emails. The free trial will be end in Nov. Jacquie made the motion to purchase the program and Mark seconded, all approved. Parish office will be closed Oct. 29 & 30. The meeting ended in prayer. Next meeting will be Nov. 17 at 6:30 p.m. Holy Spirit Hall. Mark moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Lisa. Meeting adjourned.

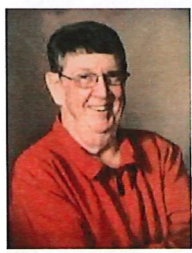
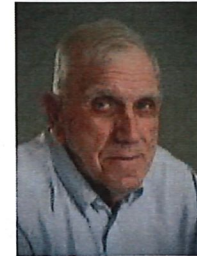
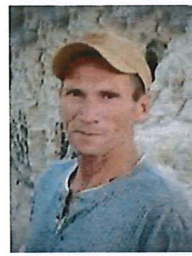
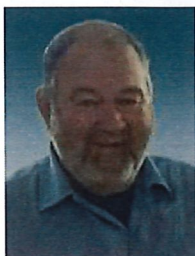
